

You have received an A4 letter on PINK paper known as the Canvass Communication B form.

Please check your form and the details for accuracy.

If you can see names and nationalities of people at your address on the form and you want to add an elector or delete somebody that no longer lives at the property, you will need to do one of the following:

- Go online at [www.registersecurely.com/VoG](http://www.registersecurely.com/VoG) enter your unique security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments; or
- By telephone, please dial 0800 0608 799, enter your unique security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments.
- Complete the form and send back in the business reply envelope, which is addressed to Vale of Glamorgan Council.

Please note

The way to apply for postal votes has now changed. You can now choose to vote by post or proxy for either Reserved (UK Parliamentary and Police and Crime Commissioner Elections), Devolved (Senedd and Local) or all elections. You will need to provide a national insurance number for Reserved polls. By marking the canvass form with a yes or no for a postal or proxy we can send you a paper postal or proxy application. Or you can now complete a postal or proxy application online for Reserved (UK Parliamentary and Police and Crime Commissioner) elections only by going to [www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote) or [www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote) . You will still need to complete a paper application for Devolved (Senedd and Local) elections.

We require you to respond to your CCB form by the deadline date of **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025.**

But you only receive an e-communication if we have your email address. If you do receive a Canvass e-communication and wish to opt out, please let us know.

After **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025**, we will attempt to call any non responders that we have a telephone number for, to gain a response. Then a **PINK** reminder canvass form will be hand delivered to any remaining non responding properties from **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2025**. Failure to respond to this final letter by **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2025** will result in no changes being made to your household details at publication of the Revised Register of Electors on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025**.
