

You have received an A3 form on PINK paper known as the Canvass Communication Form.

Please check your form and the details for accuracy.

If you want to add an elector or delete somebody that no longer lives at the property, you will need to do one of the following:

- o Go online at [www.registersecurely.com/VoG](http://www.registersecurely.com/VoG) enter your security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments; or
- o By telephone, please dial 0800 0608 799, enter your security details which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments.
- o Complete the form and send back in the business reply envelope, which is addressed to The Vale of Glamorgan Council.

Please note

The way to apply for postal votes has now changed. You can now choose to vote by post or proxy for either Reserved (UK Parliamentary and Police and Crime Commissioner), Devolved (Senedd and Local) or all elections. You will need to provide a national insurance number for Reserved polls. By marking the canvass form with a yes or no for a postal or proxy we can send you a paper postal or proxy application. Or you can now complete a postal or proxy application online for Reserved (UK Parliamentary and Police and Crime Commissioner) elections only by going to [www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote) or [www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote)

You will still need to complete a paper application for Devolved (Senedd and Local) elections.

**We require you to respond to your CCF form by the deadline date of Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2025.** Failure to respond to this final letter by this date will result in no changes being made to your household details at publication of the Revised Register of Electors on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025.**

We would appreciate a prompt response during this process.

Please remember that due to the changes in legislation 14–16-year-olds can now be added to the Register in readiness to vote when they turn 16. They will only be able to vote in some elections, not all elections.
