#### THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL (COWBRIDGE ROAD & ST ATHAN ROAD, ST ATHAN) (30MPH and 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2022

- 1. On the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 the Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2 & 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers made an Order the general effect of which is as described in the Schedules below.
- 2. The Order will come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022 or on the dates that the signs and road markings are in place, whichever is the later and shall be referred to as The Vale of Glamorgan Council (Cowbridge Road & St Athan Road St Athan) (30mph and 40mph Speed Restriction and Revocation) Order 2022. - 3. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the same or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

### SCHEDULE 1

### Revoke the following speed restriction Order in its entirety:

The County Council of South Glamorgan (St. Athan Road, Eglwys Brewis, St. Athan) (40 mph Speed Restriction) Order 1988

### **SCHEDULE 2**

## No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of roads:

### Cowbridge Road (part) and St Athan Road (part), St Athan.

From the centre of its junction with Bingle Lane, in a generally northerly and northwesterly direction, for a distance of approximately 1,280 metres and contiguous with the 40mph speed restriction.

### **SCHEDULE 3**

# No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed at a speed greater than 40 miles per hour along the following lengths of road: St Athan Road (part), St Athan.

From a point approximately 250 metres northwest of the centre its roundabout junction with Cowbridge Road, Eglwys Brewis Road and Ffordd y Spitfire, north-westwards for a distance of approximately 1,330 metres.
