

**VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL

1. The Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act (1984) (as amended) and of all other enabling powers intends to establish a pedestrian (toucan) crossing, for the reason described in Schedule 1 and at the location described in Schedule 2 below.
