- (2) T H A T all Town and Community Council Representatives on the Community Liaison Committee, and Town and Community Council Clerks, be invited to attend the Play Sufficiency workshop scheduled for Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 at a time to be determined by the Vale of Glamorgan Council Principal Healthy Living Officer in consultation with the workshop facilitators.

### Reasons for decisions

- (1) Having regard to the contents of the report by way of a reminder to ensure that Town and Community Councils represent their communities by inputting into the Play Sufficiency process, contributing to the duty set out by Welsh Government in Section 11 of the Children and Families (Wales) Measure 2010 which places a duty on Local Authorities to assess and secure sufficient play opportunities for children in their area.
- (2) To ensure that each of the 26 Town and Community Councils within the Vale of Glamorgan are represented at the Play Sufficiency Workshop to further share information regarding the Play Sufficiency and to highlight ways in which Town and Community Councils can support children and young people to play in their communities.
