Reason for Recommendation

- 2.3 The Leader of the Council, Councillor Lis Burnett, submitted an application (attached at Appendix 2) for consideration in view of a report that was to be considered by the Council's Cabinet at a meeting on 9th June, 2022. Following the Annual Meeting of the Vale of Glamorgan Council the appointment of a Chair is scheduled to take place on 23rd June, 2022 as a result the Monitoring Officer undertook consultation on the application with the Independent Members of the Standards Committee. The application was subsequently approved as follows:
- 2.4 The application was granted to **speak**, **vote and remain in meetings** where issues are raised in respect of the Council's telecare services, domiciliary care provision, Council Tax reductions for those with mental impairment and also related to blue disabled parking badges at all meetings of the Vale of Glamorgan Council, in accordance with paragraphs (d), (e) and (f) of The Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations) (Wales) Regulations 2001 and granted until the next Local Government elections in May 2027. Committee is requested to note the position regarding this application.
